For the 6yo: 1 CCI2\*S or L with 55% dressage, clear XC and max 60 sec and max one rail in SJ

For the 7yo: 1 CCI2\*-L with 55% dressage, clear XC and max 60 sec and max one rail in SJ

Plus 1 CCI3\*S or L with 55% dressage, clear XC and max 60 sec and max one rail in SJ

The Team Manager will pay special attention to:

- Overall performance throughout the year and readiness to compete at CH-W in October
- Show jumping (at Le Lion this is very influential)

The TSC will organise two viewing days (Arville 17<sup>th</sup> of May, Waregem 19<sup>th</sup> of July) for the young horses where riders can present their young horses to the Team Manager and get tips of how to improve and how to plan the season.

- These dates are open for everyone (min eventing licence & immatriculation).
- 6y min 1\* level (top 10 results in L).
- 7y min 2\* level (XC clear result and max three down showjumping).
- Not mandatory to be present. This will not influence the selection.

These following shows can be good shows for horses in the build up to Le Lion:

- CCI Minderhout-Meerle → 30/06-03/07
- CCI Jardy → 14-17/07
- CCN Waregem-Nokere → 6-7/08
- CCI Arville → 18-21/08

None of these shows are compulsory. If you have questions about where to compete and how certain shows are to be expected, you can contact the Team Manager.

The riders who are candidate to participate at the World Championship need to be proactive:

- Send a mail to the Team Manager ([ksmeventing@aol.com](mailto:ksmeventing@aol.com)) & the Sport Director ([wendy@equibel.be](mailto:wendy@equibel.be)) with the confirmation they are interested in participating at Le Lion.
- Enter their candidature for Le Lion on [www.equibel.be](http://www.equibel.be) before CCN Nokere (6<sup>th</sup> of August)
- Send videos to the Team Manager of the horse in competition.

The Team Manager will present his proposal of selection to the Topsportcel (senior eventing) for approval. The definite selection will be communicated the 6<sup>th</sup> of September 2022.
